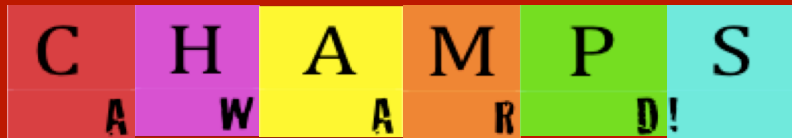

Drama News

In drama first graders have been practicing telling stories with the drama tools of voice, mind and body. First graders learned that the setting of a story tells where the story takes place. Students worked in pairs to create characters and a short story around a setting.

Students had fun imagining and creating.

They performed for their classmates.

At the end of class students can give feedback starting with the words;

- I noticed
- I saw
- I heard
- I wondered

All of our students practice being kind and encouraging to each other in drama class. 😊

Second graders come into the year knowing how to use their drama tools of voice, mind and body.

They collaborated in groups to perform scenes from The Sorcerer's Apprentice.

They did fantastic work adapting this story for our winter program, "Fritze and Quitze's Magnificent Mess".

Students continue to work on their three P's -

- Planning
- Practicing
- Performing

In the lesson, "The Greatest Show On Ice!".

Each group chose their own act such as

- fairy tales on ice
- clowns on ice
- star wars on ice
- and more!

Each group had to come up with a 2-minute story that had a problem in the middle and a solution at the end. Ask your kiddo to tell you about his or her role in, "The Greatest Show on Ice!"

- Think in pictures before words.
- Learn best by moving and doing.

- character voices
- gestures
- facial expressions
- puppets
- rhythmic language
